## AUDIO / VIDEO REQUIREMENTS

### Computer, Projector and Screen:

- Ben uses a 16" Apple MacBook Pro 2017 with USB-C to HDMI for video output (Ben will bring his own USB-C to HDMI adapter and wireless clicker). Ben's entire presentation is presented from his computer using Keynote software with a 16:9 display ratio.
- The larger the screen and the higher the quality of the projector, the better, because Ben projects many photos and videos. Ideally, screens are on either side (or both sides) of the stage and playback can be projected in a manner to be seen by the entire audience.

### Microphone and Audio:

- Ben requires a wireless lavalier microphone connected to a high-quality audio system.
- Please run sound through an AUX cable, not HDMI. Ben may control the volume via his wireless clicker which is only possible if the sound runs from his laptop using an AUX cable.
- Two (2) wireless microphones with runners for interactive portion of keynote
- Speakers/audio should be very high-quality and sufficient for the entire audience to hear sound/video clips played directly from Ben's laptop. Please make sure the sound system is functioning and tested before his arrival.

### Stage:

- If there is a podium, please position it to one side of the stage.
- Ben prefers to have his MacBook on the podium on stage (if this doesn't interfere with the presenter before him) or on a small round high-top table. HDMI cable, AUX cable, and power outlet should run to the computer. If it is preferable to have the A/V team run the presentation from the back of house, that is also fine.

### Lighting:

- Stage lights are encouraged. The venue should be dark so that the projected keynote is vivid on the screens.

### Beverage:

- Please have three (3) bottles of water or cups of water available to Ben while on stage.

**Confidence Monitor:**

- Ben prefers a confidence monitor. Bonus points if the confidence monitor can run in Presenter Mode!

**Audio and Video System Testing:**

- Ben would like to meet with the technical team at least 60 minutes prior to the presentation for setup and sound check. Ben prefers to check staging and sound and have at least 20 minutes of quiet time before his keynote.

**Internet Access Not Required:**

- Ben presents using his own laptop with embedded videos. The entire presentation and all content are self-contained and do NOT require Internet access.
